<u>WHAT CVUUS SAYS ABOUT COVID</u> We encourage you to care for yourself and each other in whatever ways you can.

1. **If you have COVID symptoms**, please don't attend CVUUS events (unless you know you have allergies or something like that). Help us protect the <u>many</u> people who are high-risk for covid who regularly come to worship and groups.

2. If you have been exposed to someone with COVID, it's fine to come to CVUUS but please follow the current CDC guidelines: mask inside around others for 10 days after exposure AND test on Day 5 (or earlier if you develop symptoms).

3. If you need COVID tests but aren't able to get them for any reason, please let us know and we will get you a test. Drop off any extras you may have in the sanctuary where they can be shared with others.

4. The only masks that adequately protect you and others from COVID are KN95 masks. Surgical masks are not good enough.
